Pohutukawa Tree


I am a pohutukawa seed,

For a kiwi kids Christmas

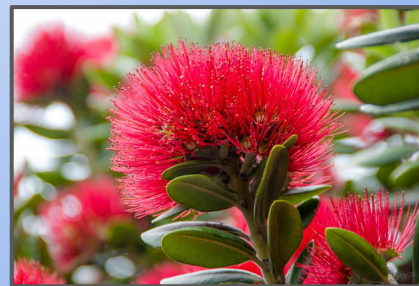

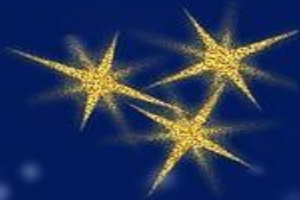
